Inside left Tom Fitchie scored twice on his debut in the Gunners' emphatic 5-0 triumph at home to Lincolnshire club Gainsborough Trinity

1930

Jack Lambert netted a hat-trick as Herbert Chapman's team compiled a 4-0 victory over Everton at Highbury

1941

Leslie Compton scored a remarkable ten goals in Arsenal's 15-2 London War Cup victory at home to Clapton Orient, who were later renamed Leyton Orient

1964

Arsenal gained a 3-2 win at home to Burnley with goals by Geoff Strong, George Armstrong and Terry Anderson

1998

Two first-half strikes from Stephen Hughes gave the Gunners a 2-0 victory over Chelsea at Highbury
